REPORTING PROCEDURE

The diocese is committed to promoting the safety, welfare and protection of children and takes all concerns, allegations, suspicions and disclosures of abuse very seriously.

The statutory authorities state as a general principle that any person who suspects that a child is being abused or is at risk of abuse has a responsibility to report their concern to the appropriate authorities.

This procedure sets out the action that shall be taken if any concern, allegation, suspicion or disclosure is made, whether current or historical, against a member of church staff (current or former).

The welfare of children is paramount.

- If a person suspects or is told a child is being or has been abused by a member of church staff (current or former) he/she should inform one of the designated liaison persons in the diocese.
- The diocesan designated liaison person informs the Bishop, the Gardaí/PSNI and TUSLA/HSCE immediately. A formal report is completed.
- If the diocesan designated liaison person is not available or the circumstances of the complaint indicate that this action may not be appropriate, the person should go straight to the Gardaí/PSNI and TUSLA/HSCE. However, it is recommended that in this case advice and support be sought from the National Office for Safeguarding Children in the Catholic Church in Ireland. (NOSCCCI).
